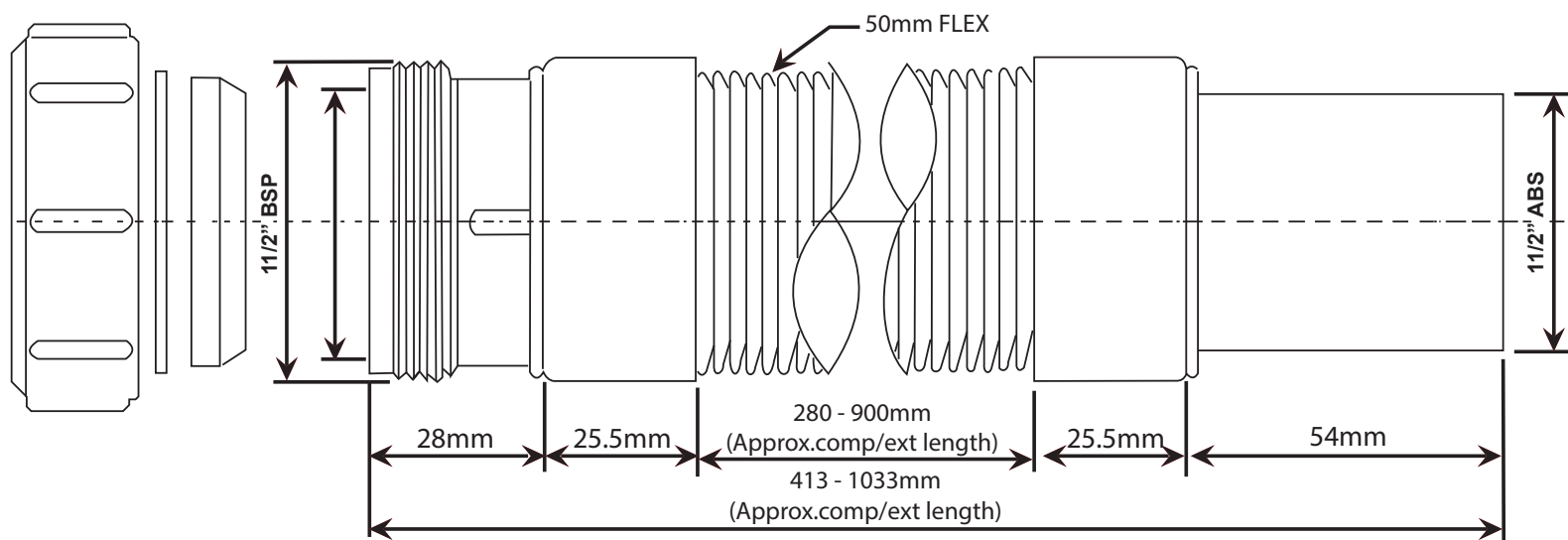




Flexi Pipe For All Shower Trays

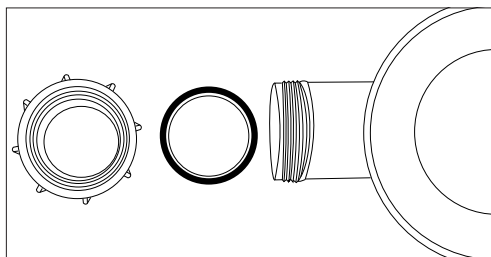


Your Flexi Pipe is an essential part of almost any shower tray plumbing system in tricky installations where rigid piping would be difficult to fit, adjustable from as little as 413mm out to 1033mm offering versatility in tight or awkward spaces.

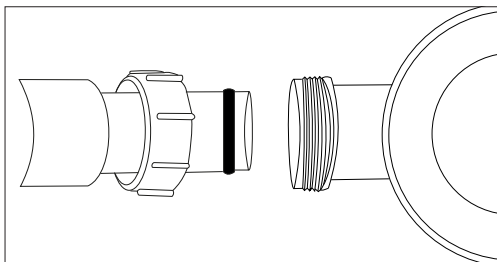

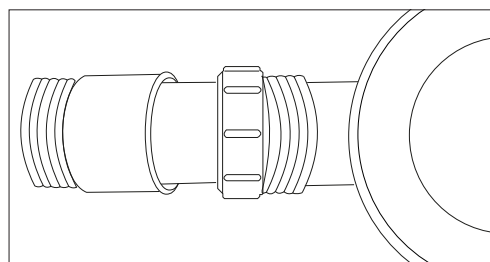
Installation



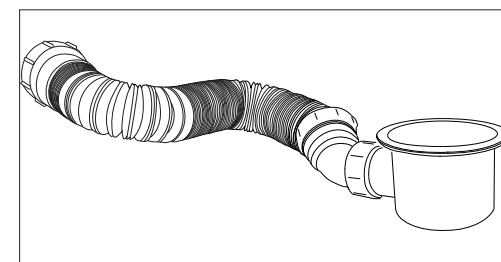
1/ Using a suitable waste unit having a 40mm compression fit connection, disassemble the nut and seals from the unit.



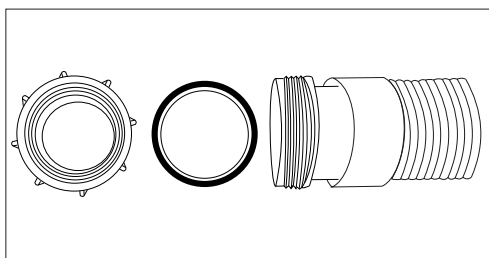
2/ Reassemble the nut and seals from the unit onto the unthreaded open end of the Flexi Pipe.



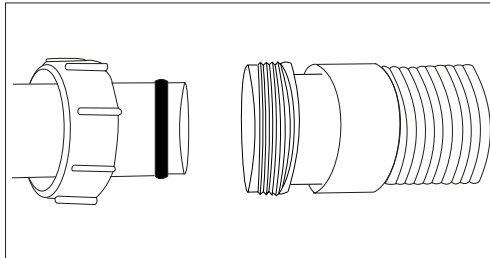
3/ Attach the Flexi Pipe to the waste unit ensuring that the end is fully inserted into the unit and then ensure all connections are tight.



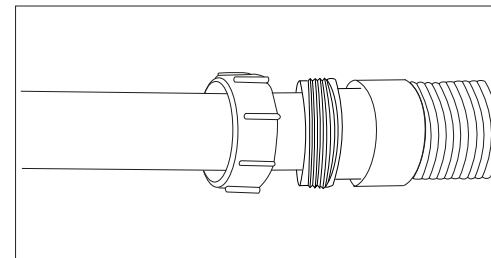
4/ Extend and shape the Flexi Pipe as required ensuring a drainage gradient of not less than 1 in 40 without sagging.



5/ To assemble on to the connecting pipework (must to BS EN 1451) by disassembling the nut and seals from the Flexi Pipe.



6/ Reassemble the nut and seals from the Flexi Pipe onto the pipework.



7/ Ensure the pipework is fully inserted into the Flexi Pipe and then tighten all connections.

All pipework and connections **MUST** now be pressure tested and checked for water leaks and adequate flow.
DO NOT PROCEED IF NOT SATISFIED.

Commonly Asked Questions:

Q Can I connect two Flexi Pipes together to extend the length.

A Yes, this can easily be achieved with two or more pipes connected as the connections will permit this, however, ensure the drainage angle is maintained at not less than 1 in 40 without the line sagging.

Q Will the flexi Pipe last.

A Yes, your Flexi Pipe is durable under normal conditions and will perform well for many years.

Q What is the flow rate of the Flexi Pipe.

A The average flow rate will normally be between 26 & 48 Litres per minute depending on gradient and the amount of bends in the line.

Q Will the Flexi Pipe clog excessively.

A Your Flexi Pipe is not excessively prone to clogging and blockages can easily be prevented by cleaning your waste unit trap regularly removing hair and debris.

Q Can I use a powerful acid, solvent or mechanical drain cleaner.

A We do not advise using powerful acid or solvent drain cleaners as these may damage seals. And mechanical drain cleaners may have sharp fittings that could cause a leak.
